Sometimes you need to recall a (huge number of) libraries, which fit a certain DSN pattern.

You're lucky if these DSNs (by accident) are just any of these:

- the staging libraries for a specific package
- all baseline 0 libs from 1, or all applications

Because in those cases you could consider using the trick described in <u>Recall all baseline 0 libs or pkg staging libs</u> to easily trigger these recalls via ChangeMan ZMF.

If you're not so lucky, you should consider facilitating this process, e.g. using the approach to address this issue as documented in the $\underline{Z\text{-Clues}}$ (login required).
